Here are some of summer's must-see events in Costa Mesa.



OC Pride Afterparty

The 2023 OC Pride Parade and Festival take place in neighboring Santa Ana, but the official Pride afterparty is at OC's queer-friendly nightclub, <u>STRUT Bar & Club</u>. STRUT is hosting multiple events over OC Pride weekend.



United Ukrainian Ballet + Broadway Shows at SCFTA

At the cultural center of the city is <u>Segerstrom Center for the Arts</u>. OC's stunning performing arts and theater complex and home to musicals, dance, concerts and more. The United Ukrainian Ballet presents *Giselle* June 29 - July 2 at Segerstrom Center for the Arts in support of BlueCheck Ukraine. Alexei Ratmansky's new interpretation of one of the greatest romantic ballets has received critical acclaim. Don't miss other hot Broadway shows this summer like *Tina*: *The Tina Turner Musical* this July, celebrating the life and music of the recently departed legendary singer.



OC Fair + Toyota Concert Series

Costa Mesa's biggest event of the year, the <u>OC Fair</u> returns July 14 – August 13 with the theme "Happy Together." The Orange County Fair is the ninth-largest fair in the United States and thrills visitors with its wide array of events, rides, carnival, fantastic food and the biggest Ferris wheel on the West Coast. Don't miss the <u>Toyota Concert Series</u> at Pacific Amphitheater, the 3,000-seat outdoor stadium located on the grounds of the OC Fair. Enjoy months of summer concerts for music lovers of every genre, including artists like Robin Thicke, Ne-Yo and Mario, Dwight Yoakam, Smokey Robinson – and a concert ticket includes attendance to the OC Fair. Fair tickets should be purchased in advance at ocfair.com.



Free Admission to OCMA

Costa Mesa is also home to the stunning new <u>Orange County Museum of Art</u>, which opened in October 2022 and is free to visitors, thanks to a generous endowment. Home to over 4,500 works of art, OCMA's permanent collection focuses on art produced during the twentieth and twenty-first centuries by artists with connections to California, plus various visiting exhibits.



Free Art Walk


Visual arts abound in the city, including public sculptures by Joan Miro and Richard Serra, an outdoor sculpture garden by Isamu Noguchi and Orange County's largest mural by Shepard Fairey. Highlighting over 20 important pieces of public art, the city offers a free Costa Mesa Art Walk audio tour available on mobile phones.



Summer Sounds Free Concerts

Find the wonderful free outdoor Summer Sounds concert series on the Julianne and George Argyros Plaza. It's a specially curated program of some of Southern California's most unique and eclectic artists. Concerts are free with a reservation and will take place on Friday evenings from June 2 to July 28. Reservations for the concert series can be made online at scfta.org. Visit nearby Avenue of the Arts, A Tribute Portfolio Hotel – one of the series sponsors – for handcrafted

cocktails in their chic music-themed bar and restaurant, Silver Trumpet. Check the <u>scfta.org</u> <u>calendar</u> for other events on the Plaza, like free Tuesday night dance classes.
