Adults attending with children should be aware of the adult content and make their own decision as to how mature their child is in handling this material. We do not have children's menus or prices. Please call and talk to a representative.

**RESERVATIONS:** Public show reservations are prepaid by credit card with entree and dessert selections chosen at the time of reservation. All reservations are made online or through Killer Entertainment by phone. (Walk-ins are accepted if we are not sold out. We suggest calling the morning of the show to find out if we have seats available. )
