General admission, concert and action sports tickets, as well as the popular Super Pass can be purchased online or from the on-site Box Office. The Super Pass covers admission for all 23 days and also allows fairgoers express entry at all gates, 2-for-1 tickets for select concerts and events, 20% off the first purchase of fair merchandise, a souvenir pin and carnival value book.
