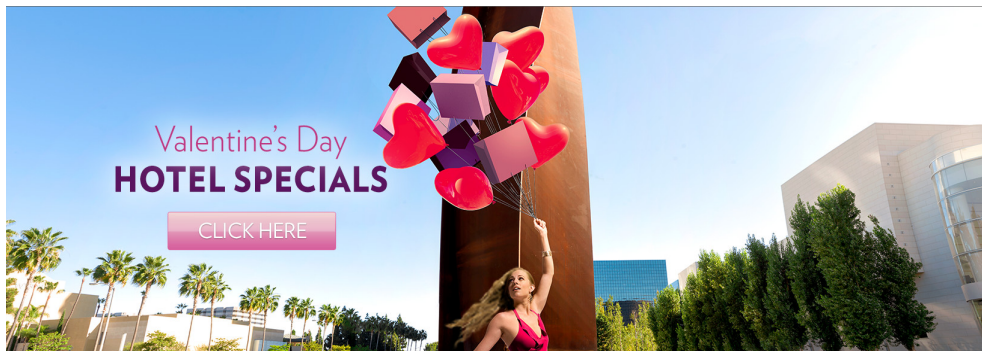




## Valentine's Day Weekend Specials in Costa Mesa
